<u>Primary School Applications - a message from Devon County Council Admissions</u>

"If your child was born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020, they will be due to start primary school in September 2024. For the best chance of getting them a space at your preferred school, make sure you apply by the deadline of **Monday 15th January 2024**. You can apply online at www.devon.gov.uk/admissiononline

You will find <u>lots of information on our education website to help you with your application</u>, including a step-by-step guide and a link to the <u>online portal</u> to submit your application. If you are unable to apply online, you can call the Education Helpline on 0345 155 1019 and request a paper form."

It is very important you make an application - your child's name MUST be on the list for your preferred school to have any chance of starting at that school in September 2024

Attendance

It is really important that we accurately record our attendance data, so if your child is absent please telephone or email Mrs Lewis on 580 551 or stokenham@southhamsfederation.org.uk
Regular attendance has a positive effect on the motivation and attainment of pupils. We believe that children who attend school regularly are more likely to feel settled in school, maintain friendships and gain the most benefit from their learning. Please keep in mind that missed days easily mount up and it is easy to underestimate the amount of time your child may miss throughout the year. It is a government legal requirement that all children should attend school for 190 days each academic year. The government requirement is that we monitor attendance.

We are legally required to send out letters to parents whose children's attendance falls below a certain level. As part of our commitment to supporting all parents and carers with their child's attendance we will keep you up to date with their attendance percentage each term. Coming home today will be their attendance certificates from Autumn Term 2023.

Snow Plans

We haven't had any snow yet but if we do have any severe weather in the future the following plans will be put into action:

Should We Need to Close the School Before the Start of the Day:

In the event of severe weather, particularly snow, the procedures are as follows:

- If parents feel that it is difficult to transport their children to and from school because of severe weather they should feel free to keep their children at home.
- If parents feel that it may be difficult for school transport to operate they should also feel free to keep their children at home.
- If the School is closed parents will be emailed before 8.30am.
- There will be a message on the School website; http://stokenhamprimaryschool.co.uk/ and we will also notify Devon County Council http://new.devon.gov.uk/schools/closure/ so they can put a message on their website. It will also be broadcast via Heart radio.
- Please do not try and call School.

Should We Need to Close the School During the Day:

- In the event of a sudden heavy snowfall during school time we will send emails and text messages to families advising them that we are closing the school.
- If you receive a message saying we are closing the school please reply to this message stating whether your child will be collected and by whom or whether your child should travel on the bus.
- If Tally Ho are not running school transport we will let you know in our message.
- We will look after your child until we have received a response from you.
- Please contact school through Schoolcomms /email system, to avoid the school phone line becoming clogged.

Please note that there could be a considerable delay before buses leave school because:

- a) Drivers cannot be on permanent standby
- b) We cannot allow children to leave school until we are sure they will be met at the end of their journey.

School staff will not leave the premises themselves until all children have been collected.
