Year 3 Extended Residential Day – Thursday 9th May

Around the School this week

Year 4 are exploring the work of Yinka Shonibare, a sculptor who has exhibited his work in The Box in Plymouth and on the Fourth Plinth in Trafalgar Square. This week we made clay figures, imagining them looking at one of his works in a gallery or on the Fourth Plinth.









The Reception children are continuing to enjoy their topic linked to farming, growing and *Jack and the Beanstalk*. This week they have been busy planting beans, a range of seeds and planting and exploring a variety of herbs using their senses.











This term in PE, Year 2 are learning about attacking and defending. They have been learning about simple attacking and defending principles and how to apply them as a team and how to move from defence into attack. They have also been learning how to balance a ball and walk round the room at the same time without dropping it or letting anyone else take it from them.

Notices and Reminders

<u>Uniform and Water Bottles</u> - Please remember that all clothing that comes into school with your child needs to be clearly labelled. They will be changing for PE and for swimming. On cooler days they will need a coat and really importantly they will need a freshly filled water bottle. All these items need to be named please - it will make everyone's life a lot easier. Thank you.

<u>Walking or cycling to school</u> - now that the weather is more spring-like a great number of children are now able to walk or cycle to school. We encourage this and ask that if you are driving to and from school you keep a keen eye out for small pedestrians and cyclists. We also ask the parents of small children who are walking or cycling along Kiln Lane to be very aware at all times as we understand that there have been some 'near misses' when children are permitted to run or cycle ahead and they may not be road aware!

<u>Worms and Nits</u> - rather a strange combination maybe, but please can we ask that all parents to rigorously check for nits over the weekend and additionally instil a thorough cleaning/handwashing regime for their children. We have unfortunately had some cases of both nits and worms in school.

<u>Contact Arrangements</u> - If you have recently moved house, changed your telephone number or other contact details or your circumstances have changed - please contact Mrs Lewis in the office and we can update our records accordingly.

<u>End of School Pick up Arrangements</u> - Please note that if your child goes home on a school bus, we must be told of any changes to this arrangement. They will automatically be put on their respective school bus <u>unless you tell us otherwise</u>. Any changes to pick-up arrangements for "bus" children and those also collected by parents must be written in your child's reading record for the attention of their class teacher, or emailed/telephoned to the office. Our staff will not accept verbal messages from children regarding their going home arrangements.

<u>Changes to your Financial Situation</u> - If your circumstances have changed recently and you feel that your child may be entitled to Free School meals due to your financial circumstances, please see Mrs Lewis in the first instance. All applications are completed via the Devon County Council Citizen's portal. If you are confirmed as eligible, please let Mrs Lewis in the office know. Any information you provide us with will be treated in the utmost confidence.
