Emergency Medical Consent

The safety and wellbeing of our pupils is our highest priority. In line with current guidance on supporting children with medical conditions, including allergy management and emergency response procedures, **we ask all parents and carers to provide consent** for appropriately trained school staff to seek and administer emergency medical treatment when it is not possible to contact a parent or carer immediately. This may include the use of emergency medication, such as an adrenaline auto-injector in a life-threatening allergic reaction, and arranging urgent medical assistance where required.
