Summary of PPG spending 2014-2015

Objectives in spending PPG:

- a) To ensure that outcomes for pupils receiving the pupil premium grant are in line or better than all other groups within the school.
- b) To ensure that progress for pupils receiving the pupil premium grant are in line or better than all other groups within the school.
- c) To support the purchase of school uniform, access to extra-curricular clubs and contribute towards the cost of residential trips and visits.

Summary of spending and actions taken for 2014-15 academic year:

- a) Implemented individual and group interventions according to specific needs and reviewed and amended half termly.
- b) 1:1 Tuition
- c) Subsidising of residential trips.

Outcomes to date:

The progress of all groups has continued to be good in the past year and above the school average, including that of those pupils entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant. This progress for Pupil Premium children has been significant across the whole school in English, Reading, Writing, Mathematics and Science.

Planned spending and actions for 2015-2016 academic year:

- a) Planned targeted interventions by HLTA's including a contribution to HLTA costing across the school.
- b) Funding of TA's to support targeted interventions following teacher guidance.
- c) 1:1 Tuition for identified pupils.
- d) Subsidising educational trips to support curriculum development and entitlement.
- e) £100 bursary for each child entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant to offset the cost of school uniform, attending extra-curricular clubs and subsidising educational trips to support curriculum development and entitlement.
